FAMOUS TOURIST SPOTS NEAR THE VENUE

Kumarakom, and its backwaters are located about 16 kilometers from the Venue. The Kumarakom bird sanctuary, boat cruises and treks are major attractions.





Vaikom Mahadeva Temple is an ancient Shiva temple about 28 km from the venue. The nearby Ettumanoor and Kaduthuruthy Shiva Temples are considered mythologically related.

Pathiramanal Island is a bird watcher's paradise. This small island on the backwaters is a safe haven for hundreds of rare migrating birds.





Malarikkal Waterlily Field:

Malarikkal is a small tourism hamlet located 13 km from the venue. There are mangrove forests, paddy fields and coconut groves in the village. There are widespread waterways and canals.
